This is a multi-disciplined role. The successful applicants' duties will include:

Primary

Survey, Installation & Inspection of Portable Fire Extinguishers & Fire Safety Signage
Service Maintenance & Inspection of Fire Hose Reels

Secondary

Service Maintenance & Inspection of Wet / Dry Riser Systems

The applicant must meet the skill requirements below for the Primary Role. Training will be provided to meet the secondary role requirements.

Technical Knowledge, Skills & Qualifications

- Candidate should be experienced & qualified to a minimum level of FIA / FETA [Theory & Practice of Servicing Portable Fire Extinguishers] or equivalent level
- It may be beneficial for the candidate to have successfully completed all of the requirements of the BAFF ST104 scheme covering the Maintenance & Servicing of Portable Fire Extinguishers – Further Training to this standard will however be provided to the successful applicant over time.
- Good communication skills; verbal & written.
- Full UK driving license.
- Standard CRB Disclosure [within last 3 years]; can obtain on commencement.

Further Training to be Given

Within the first 12 months of employment, the applicant will be required to attend training courses. These include Certificate in Health & Safety, Manual Handling Certificate, Asbestos Awareness, FIA – Maintenance of Portable Fire Extinguishers [where applicable]. Within the first 24 months of employment, the applicant will be required to complete all necessary training to become a BAFF Registered Technician [where applicable].

Working Hours

Normal working hours are from 08.00 to 17.00, Monday till Friday. Occasional Saturday work may be required. All travelling time [not commuting] is paid as overtime when leaving from home or returning straight home. This is generally only necessary when leaving early & finishing late.

Regular overtime will be required.

Tools, Equipment & Transport

A company van will be provided which is taken home in the evenings. We will require that the successful applicant has secure parking at home within sight of the house. It is very important that that this vehicle is kept clean & presentable.

All PPE (including uniform & safety shoes) & manuals are provided by the company. Technicians' are required to provide & wear a smart black leather belt.

All tools, test apparatus & access equipment [where required] will be provided by the company.

Salary & Benefits

A permanent position will be offered to the successful applicant subject to completion of a trial period lasting 12 weeks.

Salary is paid weekly, one week in arrears, directly into a nominated bank account. Salary will be set at a level based on experience & will be reviewed when all necessary training & qualifications are attained.

Overtime will be paid at a time + ¼ for all hours worked Monday to Friday before 08.00 & after 17.00. Saturday mornings will be time + ½. Saturday afternoons & Sunday will be at double time.
